An advertisement, like the one shown above, is a kind of public notice asking for or offering services. It provides information about buying and selling property or other goods, etc. It also aims at seeking or providing information about missing persons, pets, belongings, etc. Thus, an advertisement is a convenient medium to seek or give informtion to the public for any need or purpose.

The world as we know is primarily made of two categories of people - the manufacturers and consumers. In order to sell their wares, manufacturers have to create awareness about their products or services. This message is intended for a target consumer base.

Advertising provides the perfect message and placing this message on the appropriate medium ensures maximum reach in minimum investment. Even in our day-to-day life, we often need to resort to either employing services, buying products or to advertise for the services we might be providing.

Before we commence to understand in detail, what advertisements are, it is important to see the weightage that has been placed on this short writing topic.

According to the latest CBSE syllabus for class XI, the Writing Section includes Advertisement Writing as a component to assess your writing skills in the short format.

Marking Scheme

As per the latest CBSE pattern, 1 question will be asked on advertisement for 3 marks (with internal choice). The marks breakdown as per the new pattern is as follows:

Format (1 mark)

- Essential to score 1 mark.
- Format (style) of 'Title' depends on the type of advertisement
- Identifying the type of advertisement and thus its format is important.
- Upper case or bold letters is preferred to capture attention.


Content (1 mark)

- It is the main body of an advertisement. It should be within 50 words.
- Should cover all suggested CBSE value points (necessary information) to easily score 1 mark.

Expression (1 mark)

- The overall quality of writing is judged to decide if the final 1 mark should be given or not.
- Grammatical accuracy and correct spellings are important to score full marks.

Types of Advertisements

Advertisements are of two types:


- Classified Advertisements
- Commercial or Display Advertisements

It can be well understood with the help of the flowchart given:









I. CLASSIFIED ADVERTISEMENTS

Classified advertisements are like short messages. Our newspapers/magazines feature a large number of such ads on a regular basis. The uniqueness of this type of ad and the reason for its immense popularity, is that they cost lesser than commercial ads, mainly because they occupy little space. Brevity is unique to classified ads. The message they convey is lucid and succinct, but effective. It commonly feature in columns of newspapers and magazines. Classifieds often advertise available jobs, or people seeking goods and property for purchase or sale. They also serve the purpose of informing or seeking information about some person or belongings which may have gone missing.

Important points to Remember

- Do not clutter the advertisement by using any design or block around the written content.
- Use a box to write the classified advertisement, as this will keep it distinct from the rest of the page.
- Employ attention grabbing words and catchy phrases.
- Use simple language.
- State facts as they are.
- It is not mandatory to write the ad in complete sentences, since the focus is on saying more in less words.
- Keep it formal.
- Keep it short (not more than 50 words).
- State the purpose of the ad clearly at the top. For example: Mention if the advertisement pertains to Wanted, situation Vacant, Missing, To Let, etc.

- Make sure to include all the important details by using commas.
- Give contact details such as name/address/ telephone number/email id.

Types of Classified Advertisements

The following is a comprehensive list of the types of classified advertisements, along with an explanation of the techniques to write them accurately:

1. Situation Vacant / Wanted

This type of classified ad is written to announce opening/s in a company. It also announces the availability of a person for a particular job profile/location.

Begin the ad by writing Situation Vacant/Wanted in capital letters.

- In the Situation Vacant ad, mention the name of the company and the post the company is seeking people for.
- Specify the number of vacancies per post.
- Enlist the gender/qualifications/qualities/age/experience/ designation of the person, the company is seeking.
- Clearly mention the last date to receive applications, and the mode through which applications may be sent, i.e., whether by post, by hand or through courier or email.
- In case of a Situation Wanted ad, mention the gender/ qualification/qualities/age/experience/designation that a person is seeking an opportunity for.
- Once the job role is clearly mentioned, mention other preferences, such as location, expected/offered salary, and perks.
- Conclude the ad by mentioning the name and details of the person to be contacted for further queries/guidance.




Technique

- A Property Sale/Purchase ad must begin with Plot/House for Sale/Purchase OR Available/Wanted Plot/House written in capital letters.
- Enlist the details of the property that you are looking to buy/sell. These may include the floor at which the house is, the number of rooms in the house, or total area of the plot in square metres, expected/offered price range, etc.
- It is also a good idea to mention any specific amenities that are available or that you are seeking when looking at properties. For example, wanted a Flat in a colony with a park or a club house, etc.
- Important details to mention include the location of plot/house.
- It would be good to include the name of the development authority of the area.
- Include the type of property that you are looking to sell/purchase. For example, plot, house, warehouse, etc. Also, mention for what purpose the property will be used. For example, residential, commercial, industrial, etc.
- Make sure to conclude with your name and contact details to facilitate potential buyers/sellers to get in touch with you.

Technique

- Vehicle Sale/Purchase ad must begin with the words 'Vehicle for Sale/Purchase' written in capital letters.
- The ad must mention the type of vehicle, i.e., 2-wheeler, 4-wheeler, tractor, etc.
- The model of the vehicle, for example, Maruti WagonR, Hyundai Santro, Bajaj Pulsar, etc. must be mentioned clearly.
- The colour and vintage of the vehicle (year of manufacture) are a must to include.
- Any additional modifications, accessories and insurance status, etc. too must be mentioned.
- The mileage and condition of the vehicle too must find a mention in this ad.
- Though optional it is recommended to include the expected price at which you would be willing to buy/sell the vehicle.
- The ad can be concluded with your name/address/phone number/email id to facilitate potential buyers/sellers to get in touch with you.

Technique

- An ad for selling/purchasing household goods must begin with name of the item to be sold/ purchased.
- Specify the item you are looking to sell/purchase. For example, refrigerator, bed, sofa, water purifier, etc.
- Give a description of the item mentioned for sale/purchase. For example, mention brand, model, vintage (year of manufacturing), etc.
- Mention the condition of the item. For example, in mint condition, new, next to new, gently used, etc.
- Give a price range at which you are looking to sell/buy the item.
- Conclude with your contact details to facilitate potential buyers/sellers to get in touch with you.

Examples:











- The ad must begin with the words To Let/Available/Looking to Hire (in keeping with the purpose) in capital letters.
- Clearly state the type of accommodation that you have for renting. For example: East-facing or 3 BHK, etc.
- Briefly describe the accommodation in terms of whether it is an independent house, or a flat in a gated community.
- → A dealer or owner could also specify whether they seek a small family, bank officer, bachelors, etc. to rent out the house to.
- Specify the total area, the floor number, ventilation, location, etc.
- You may also want to mention amenities that are available, such as playing area, club house, gym or amphitheatre, etc.
- Make a clear mention of the expected rent that you are seeking.
- Also mention if the rent is negotiable or non-negotiable.
- Conclude the classified ad with your name and contact details for the renter/ rentee to get in touch with you.

Technique

- The ad must begin with the word 'Missing' written in capital letters.
- Provide a description including details such as name, age, height, built, colour of complexion and clothes worn when last seen in case of missing person.
- Any visible identification marks must be specifically mentioned too.
- In case of a missing pet, details such as breed, colour of eyes and fur, any chain/collar specifications, etc. must be mentioned.
- Mention the date/time/area in which the missing person/pet was last seen in.
- Specify the reward that is being offered to the informer in lieu of information/leads about the missing person/pet.
- Conclude the classified ad with your name/address/phone number/email id.







II. COMMERCIAL OR DISPLAY ADVERTISEMENTS

Commercial or Display ads, as they are commonly known, could be an announcement of an event, an inauguration ceremony, a promotion or a simple discount declaration of the product/service it is advertising. This type of ad may be published in a newspaper or magazine, or released simultaneously over several mediums such as TV, radio, Internet, etc. as part of a synchronised media campaign.

It is important to understand that the purpose of commercial ads as compared to other ads is to attract attention. The spending on these ads is a lot more than classified ads since they occupy more space. They are also visually more attractive and employ creative design/language elements to entice its target audience. Characterised by catchy slogans and wordplay, these ads are a fancier version of classified ads.

There is no hard and fast rule about the format of commercial ads. It is completely at the discretion of the individual/agency creating the ad to use any/all elements of design and language to make a creative ad. The whole idea is to ensure it meets its purpose, which may to be create awareness/sell/announce discount.

However, some imperatives include:




