ACROSS

There is a little problem with the bridge **across** the river.

AFTER

The gardener broke his slippers running **after** the children.

ALONG

The children ran **along** the road to meet their cousins.

AT

The journalist threw the shoe **at** the minister.

FOR

All these pilgrims are heading **for** Sabarimala.

INTO

Champu jumped **into** the river on seeing Sheru.

ONTO

The monkey climbed **onto** the branch seeing the crocodile.

TO

Billu and Pinky are going **to** their uncle's house tomorrow.

The jubilant crowd is running **toward** the captain.
