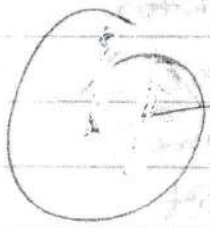
- (c) Mijhid was an intelligent animal. It is obvious from the line given below:
