He ~~allows~~ <sup>wants the</sup> the child to mourn his loss for He ~~gives~~ <sup>gives</sup> the child ~~freedom~~ <sup>freedom</sup> to breathe to and assimilate his first loss. The poet says that loss is a part and parcel of life and that the boy is learning to assume responsibility for his actions and face their consequences. His ~~turn~~ <sup>learning</sup> learning curve has begun which will encourage strength of character, equanimity of mind and stoicism.
