Directions: In the following questions given below, there are two statements marked as Assertion (A) and Reason (R). Read the statements and choose the correct option:

- c. Assertion (A) is true, but Reason (R) is false.
- d. Assertion (A) is false, but Reason (R) is true.
- **Q1. Assertion (A):** When on election duty, the government officers work under the control of the Election Commission and not the government.

Q3. Assertion (A): Secret Ballot enables a person to cast his/her vote fearlessly and secretly.

Reason (R): Secret Ballot is a voting method in which a voter's identity in an election or a referendum is anonymous.

Answer: (b) Both Assertion (A) and Reason (R) are true, but Reason (R) is not the correct explanation of Assertion (A).

Reason (R): Public opinion play an important role in formulating and implementing important programmes.

Answer: (a) Both Assertion (A) and Reason (R) are true and Reason (R) is the correct explanation of Assertion (A).

Q5. Assertion (A): Elections give the voters the right to elect their representatives or rulers.

Reason (R): Through elections, voters can't choose who will form the government and take major decisions.

Answer: (c) Assertion (A) is true, but Reason (R) is false.
