

Wisdom of Ganesh




God Shiv and Goddess Umiya had two sons, Kartikey and Ganesh. One day Ganesh and Kartikey argued on who stronger was.




At that time, God Shiv arrived and asked, "What are you doing, Ganesh and where is Kartikey?"
