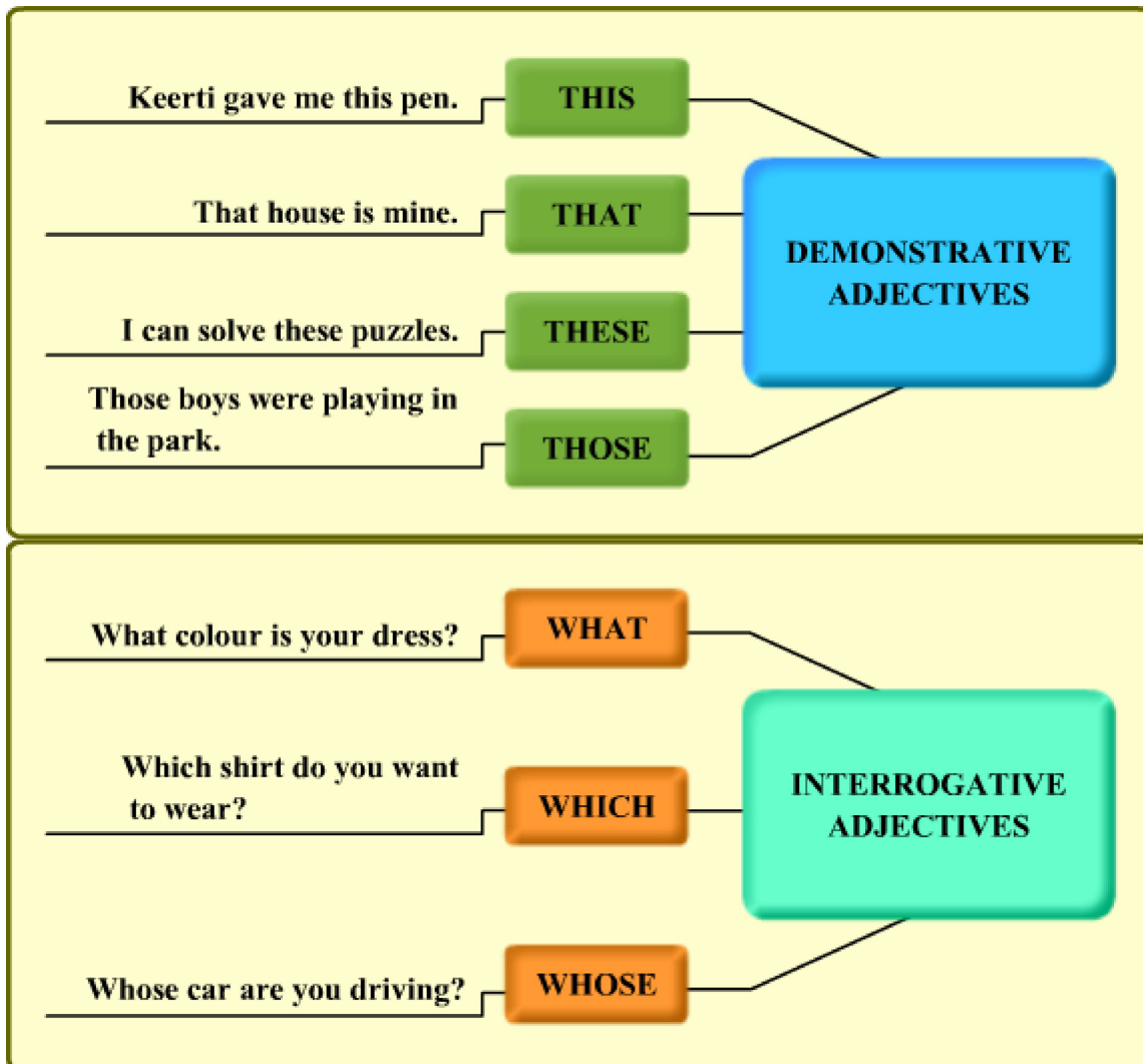

POSITIVE

Clever
Heavy
Hot

COMPARATIVE

Cleverer
Heavier
Hotter

SUPERLATIVE

Cleverest
Heaviest
Hottest

Comparative formed by adding '-er'

Superlative formed by adding '-est'

Beautiful
Difficult

More beautiful
Less difficult

Most beautiful
Least difficult

Comparative formed by adding more/less

Superlative formed by adding most/least

Good
Much
Bad

Better
More
Worse

Most
Worst

Irregular Adjectives

POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

They are the possessive forms of personal pronouns

They are immediately followed by a noun

Your book is lying on the table.

My phone is with the teacher.

Her parents are out of town.

Their performance was liked by all.
