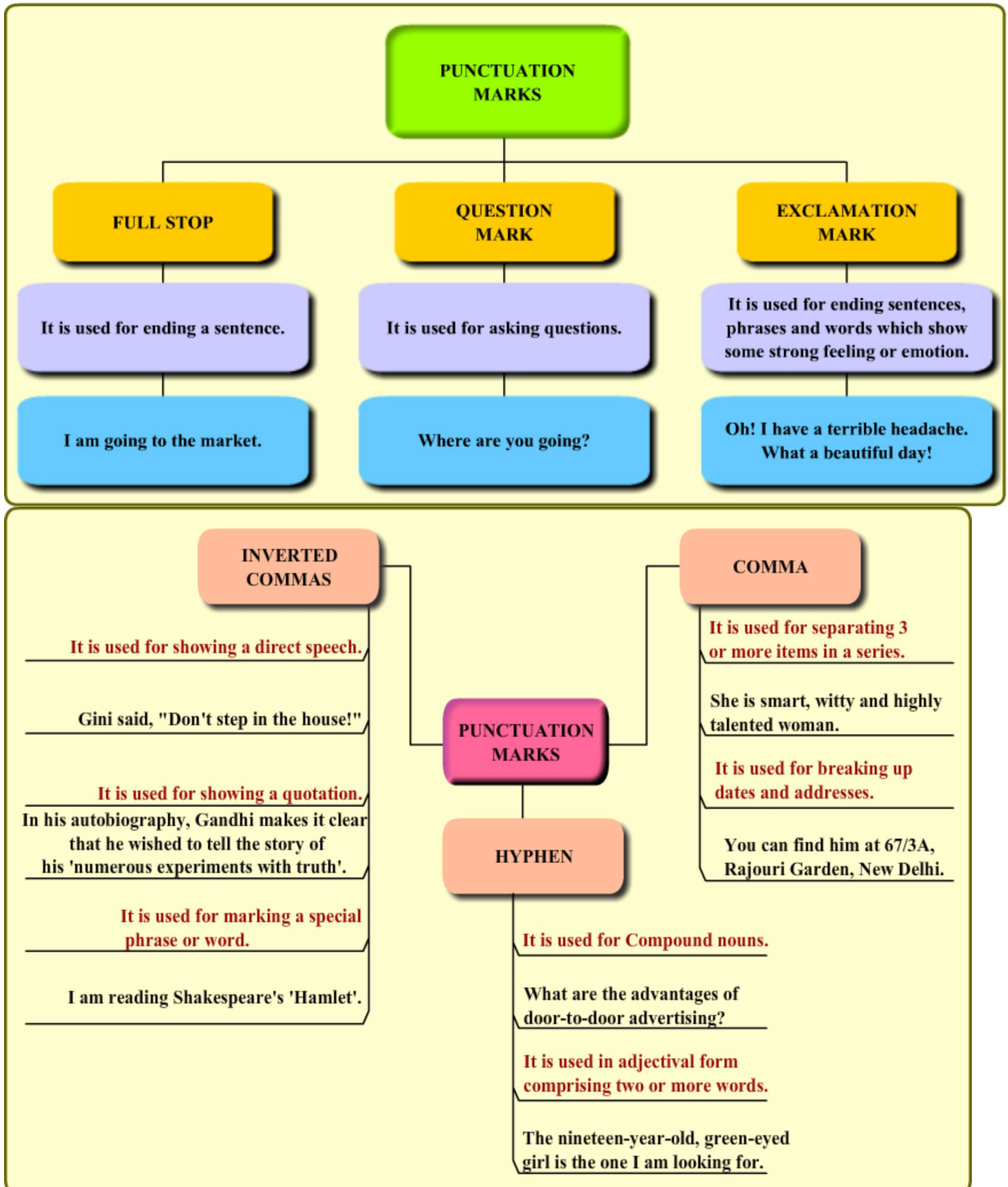


## 14. Punctuations

contracting words.

Do not – Don't  
Are not – Aren't  
Will not – Won't  
They are – They're  
Who is – Who's  
She will – She'll  
You Have – You've  
They Had – They'd

**I do** not want to see the movie.

Becomes

**I don't** want to see the movie.

## APOSTROPHE

It is used for showing the  
possessive case of nouns.

Singular noun

**Jeetu's** dog barks loudly.

Singular noun ending  
with the letter 's'

**Congress'** victory in the general  
elections was unexpected.

Plural noun

Mom! Take me to the **children's**  
park.

Plural Noun ending  
with the letter 's'

Sara is going to live in  
a **girls'** hostel.
