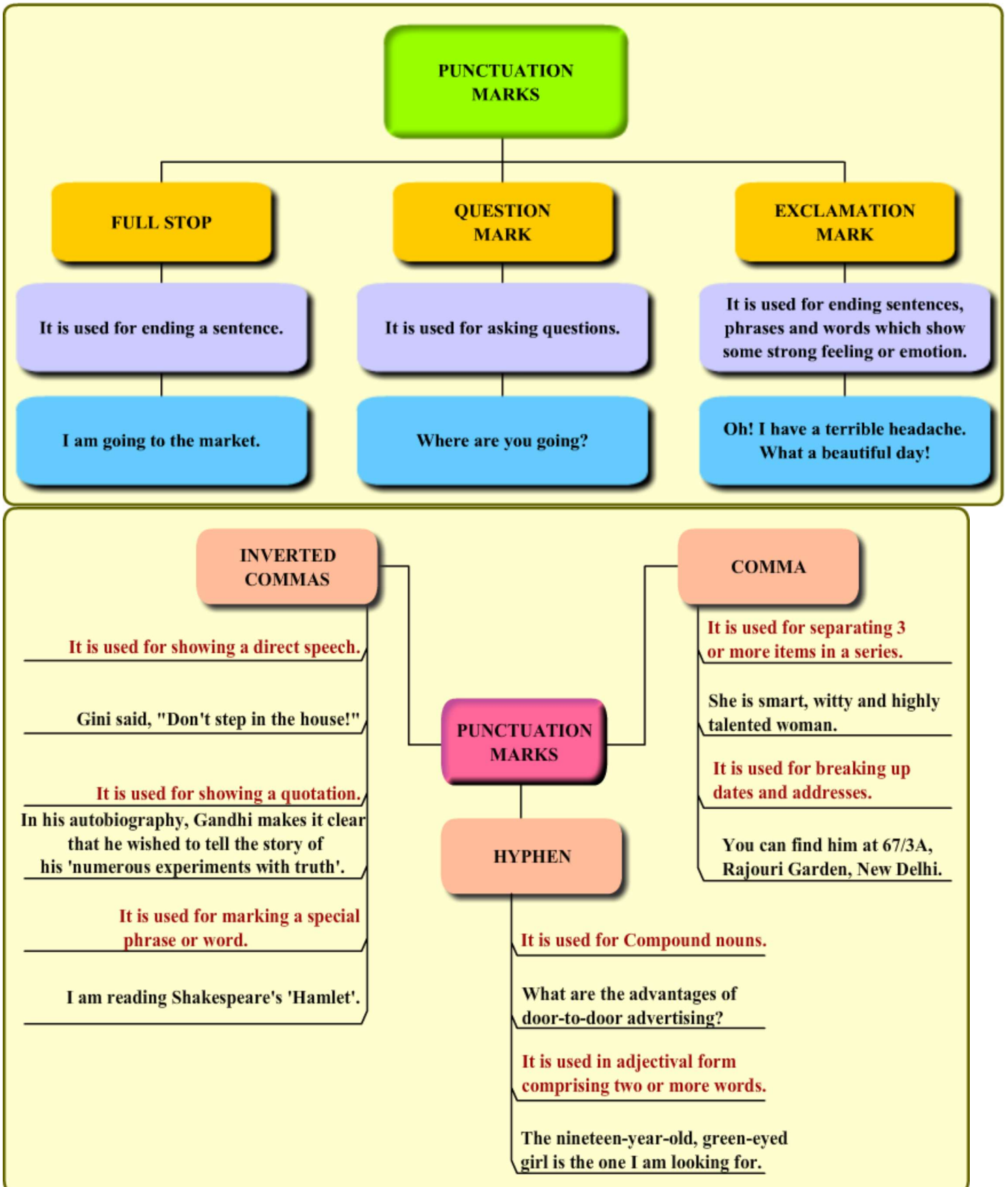


14. Punctuations

contracting words.

Do not – Don't
Are not – Aren't
Will not – Won't
They are – They're
Who is – Who's
She will – She'll
You Have – You've
They Had – They'd

I do not want to see the movie.

Becomes

I don't want to see the movie.

APOSTROPHE

It is used for showing the
possessive case of nouns.

Singular noun

Jeetu's dog barks loudly.

Singular noun ending
with the letter 's'

Congress' victory in the general
elections was unexpected.

Plural noun

Mom! Take me to the **children's**
park.

Plural Noun ending
with the letter 's'

Sara is going to live in
a **girls'** hostel.
